



DRUM MAJOR INFORMATION & SELECTION PROCEDURES

The Drum Major of the Corner High School Marching Band is the visible face of the band as well as its primary student leader. We expect our Drum Major to exemplify integrity, responsibility, work ethic, a willingness to serve, capable musicianship, confidence, and adaptability. The Drum Major is responsible for conducting the band in the stands and on the field, leading stretch block, assisting with instruction, representing the band as a student ambassador, and being available to assist the directors with various tasks outside of rehearsal. We feel that we have developed a fair method of selection.

The Drum Major will be selected via an audition process that includes the following:

1. A conducting tryout by an outside judge.
 - i. Conducting clinics will be held in the days leading up to the tryout.
2. Two teacher recommendations. (see form)
3. An interview with the Band Staff.
4. Student's body of work as perceived by the Staff. (attitude, work ethic, leadership, etc.)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will all of this take place?

- Clinics will be Wednesday, March 31; Wednesday, April 7; and Monday, April 12. The clinics will be taught by Mrs. Saunders and Mr. Murphy. Teacher recommendations will be due April 12. Tryouts will be Tuesday, April 13. Interviews will be Wednesday, April 14. All events will take place beginning after school at 3:15.

What will be taught at the clinic?

- Conducting technique, basic patterns, exercises for hand independence, dynamic cues, vocal cues, salute suggestions.

What will the conducting tryout consist of?

- Vocal commands, custom salute, conducting to a pre-recorded track.

Who can audition for Drum Major?

- Rising seniors, juniors, and sophomores are eligible. You must play an instrument in the band to be eligible to audition.
